



Wound and healing ointment

Zinc Ointment

Active ingredient: 10 g zinc oxide in 100 g ointment

Ointment for application to the skin

Read the entire information leaflet carefully before starting to use this medicinal product; it contains important information for you.

Always use this medicinal product exactly as described in this leaflet or exactly as prescribed by your doctor or pharmacist or your medical specialist.

- Keep this information leaflet. You may want to reread it at a later date.
- Ask your pharmacist if you need any additional information or advice.
- Please inform your doctor or pharmacist or medical specialist if you notice side effects. This also applies to side effects not stated in this leaflet. See section 4.
- Please consult a doctor if, after application, you do not feel better or even feel worse.

1. What is wound and healing ointment and what is it used for?

Areas of application:

To support wound healing, including moist and itchy wounds and grazes; use as a cover ointment.

2. What should I be aware of before using wound and healing ointment?

Wound and healing ointment may not be used:

- If you are allergic to zinc oxide or any other components of this medicinal product stated in section 6.

Warnings and safety precautions for use

Please consult your doctor, pharmacist or medical specialist before using the wound and healing ointment.

Using wound and healing ointment with other medication:

Please inform your doctor or pharmacist if you use, or have recently used, or intend to use other medicinal products.

The wound and healing ointment must be fully removed before applying other external products (restricted effect of other external products).

Pregnancy, lactation and fertility

Please ask your doctor or pharmacist for advice before use if you are pregnant or are nursing, if you think you might be pregnant or intend to become pregnant.

The wound and healing ointment contains wool wax and cetylstearyl alcohols

Wool wax and cetylstearyl alcohols can cause localised skin irritation (e.g. contact dermatitis).

3. How should wound and healing ointment be used?

Always use this medicinal product exactly as described in this leaflet or exactly as prescribed by your doctor, pharmacist or medical specialist. Please consult your doctor, pharmacist or medical specialist if you are unsure.

The recommended dose is: Apply wound and healing ointment between once and several times a day to the affected areas of skin and cover with a bandage.



How to use: For application to the skin.

4. What are the possible side effects?

As is the case with all medicinal products, this medicinal product can have side effects, but they do not necessarily affect everyone.

A slight burning sensation can be felt on inflamed skin when applying the wound and healing ointment. Allergic skin reactions can occasionally occur.

Reporting side effects:

Please inform your doctor or pharmacist if you notice side effects. This also applies to side effects not stated in this leaflet.

5. How should wound and healing ointment be stored?

Keep this medicine out of the reach of children.

Do not take this medicinal product if the "use by" date on the carton and container has expired. The use by date relates to the last day of the month in question.

Storage conditions: Do not store above 25 °C.

Never dispose of medicinal products in your waste water (e.g. not down the toilet or washbasin). Ask your pharmacist how you should dispose of the medicinal product if you no longer use it. 6. Pack contents and additional information

100 g wound and healing ointment contain: Active ingredient: 10 g zinc oxide.

Other ingredients: White Vaseline, viscous paraffin, wool wax alcohols, cetylstearyl alcohol (Ph. Eur.).

Packet sizes available: Original pack with 100 ml ointment.
